Peter L. Mangione

Peter L. Mangione is a Co-Director of WestEd's Center for Child and Family Studies. He has worked extensively in the fields of child development, early childhood education, research and evaluation design, and public policy. For over twenty years, he has provided leadership in the development of the Program for Infant/Toddler Care, a national model for training early childhood practitioners. Mangione was also one of the Executive Producers of the video "A World Full of Language: Supporting Preschool English Learners." Recently, he has been leading the development of preschool learning foundations and infant/toddler learning and development foundations for the California Department of Education. Mangione received his Ph.D. in Education and Human Development from the University of Rochester in 1980 and completed postdoctoral study at the Max Planck Institute for Psychiatry in Munich, Germany.
